Philosophy

- The Volusia County School Board and University High School recognize the value of athletic participation and the values and skills that can be gained by such participation. Athletics are seen as an extension or “extra” curricular part of the total educational program and should never place the academic program in a secondary role. We will field as many JV teams as participation and local competition will allow.

FHSAA Eligibility

- Must be a registered & enrolled student at University
- Must be younger than 19 years old on July 1, each year
- Has 4 years of eligibility upon completion of 8th grade (8 consecutive semesters immediately following 8th grade.)
- Must maintain a cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.0 or higher
- 9th graders – must be regularly promoted to ninth grade, satisfactory attendance & discipline in 8th grade.

What Happens When YOU are Ineligible?

- Students who are ruled ineligible due to academics are not allowed to compete in games for one semester.
- Cumulative unweighted GPA must have risen to a 2.00 or better

Pay to Participate




- Volusia County School District Fee – allows each athletic department to fund operations
- Does not guarantee playing time
- \$75.00 for your first sport
- \$25.00 for your second sport
- No additional fee for 3rd or 4th sport
- Is payable each year
- Recommended to pay online





Team Fees

- Many teams have a team fee.
- Depends on the team what it is used for...
 - Personal Uniform needs (Swimsuits, socks, hats, etc.)
 - Team Gear – Team t-shirts, sweatshirts, etc.
 - End of Season Awards and Banquets or Team Get Togethers
- Usually payable before the first competition
- Can be paid online
- Some teams have sponsorship opportunities to help offset the fees.

Important: When creating your student profile, enter the student's first and last name, and student ID. The middle name is not required. The first and last name fields are not case sensitive, but the student ID field is. You must enter a "1" before the alpha ID and the alpha ID must be in ALL CAPS (ex. 1ABCD). Please remember to print your receipt. Also, be advised that there is a small handling fee for online orders.

Athletic Facilities

Most teams practice and play on campus...with a few exceptions

Soccer – practice @Bennett, games on campus

Swimming – practice & games @ Deltona YMCA

Bowling – practice & games @ Bowling Alley in Orange City

Golf – practice & games @Debary Golf & Country

Parents are responsible for transportation to practice, home competitions held at off site facilities and some away competitions.

Practice & Try-Out Expectations

- Attendance at practices is mandatory.
 - Excused absences must be communicated to the coach before the absence
 - Repeated absences may result from dismissal from the team
 - Missing teammates hurts the development of the team
- Try-Out Procedures will be communicated on first day of practice
 - There are multiple factors that are considered when selecting a team
 - It is often the most difficult aspect of coaching
 - There are NO guaranteed spots on teams or playing time.
 - Coaches decisions are final.
 - If an athlete wishes to know what areas should be improved on for future consideration, the athlete should schedule an opportunity to speak with the coach. This will help the student-athlete develop their own self-advocacy and communication skills.

Admission to Events

Expect to pay admission for any and all games – Home & Away

Tournaments and Varsity Football will usually have parking fees

- Post Season (Districts/Regionals/States) will have increased ticket prices as dictated by the FHSAA.
- Most ticket sales will be online. Concessions, parking, some gates will be cash only.

Signing Up & Paperwork


- ✓ Paperwork includes more than just the physical.
- ✓ Paperwork & Physicals must be done every year.
- ✓ Turn in the pages the doctor signed to the Athletic Office (not to a coach)
- ✓ Your physical from River Springs does not just transfer to UHS.

School-Based Insurance Information

All student-athletes must have their own insurance per Florida law. The school, nor school district provides any insurance coverage on student-athletes.

For student-athletes who do not have their own medical insurance, an accident policy can be purchased to fulfill this requirement. Volusia County School Board partners with School Insurance of Florida for this optional coverage.

There are multiple plans and coverages available each year. Coverage becomes available the day after purchase and will expire on the Sunday before the FHSAA Fall Sport season begins (first Monday in August), no matter when the policy was purchased.

Policies for the next school year become available in July. Policies do not automatically renew.

Transfer Students

FHSAA defines a transfer student as any student who changes their mode or provider of instruction any time after either: 1) attending class for the first time in ninth grade or 2) participating in any athletic workout with a school even if it occurs during summer months.

Any student who meets the definition of a transfer must complete a GA-4 form (Recruiting Policy Affidavit) before participating in any athletic activity. This affidavit certifies that student was not recruited/unwilling/uncoerced to attend University High School for athletic purposes and that no member of the athletic department or athletic representative has spoken to the student or the student's family regarding athletic participation prior to the student registering or enrolling at University High School. This form may also be printed from your Final Forms account or using the link below. Completed forms should be returned to the Athletic Director/Department prior to participation.
